NOTES TO ENTRANTS

1 UNREGISTERED VEHICLES

Owners of vehicles without Registration, either Full or Concessional, will need "Permits to drive an Unregistered Vehicle". The Permits are valid for periods of up to 3 days and are obtainable from any branch of the S.A. Motor Registration Division.

2 INTERSTATE VEHICLES

Interstate Concessional Registrations & Club Permit Systems are recognised in South Australia, subject to the same Terms and Conditions applying in the State of origin.

3 LEFT HAND DRIVE VEHICLES & THOSE ARRIVING FROM OVERSEAS

Require a Special Permit and the Registrar may require an inspection by a Departmental Officer.

4 ACCOMMODATION

Can be arranged through RAA (Royal Automobile Association) Touring Services. You may either work through the Motoring Association in your own State or contact the RAA direct at 101 Richmond Road, Mile End South SA 5031, telephone (08) 8202 4540 and advise them of your requirements.
