DAY 1 Monday 22nd September CLEAN BOWLED

Hosted by the Motorfest Committee

After morning tea we will leave the Motorfest headquarters and drive via the west parklands to the picturesque Adelaide Oval, home of the South Australian Cricket Club. The Oval is surrounded by large trees and is set between the City and the River Torrens on the south and St Peter's Cathedral to the north.

Cricket and Football has been played at the grounds dating back to the 1870's.

In all, 16 different sports have been played at the grounds and the venue has also staged popular rock concerts.

We will be treated to a 90 minute tour of the facility, followed by a running board lunch in a nearby park.

Time is available to visit the Murray mouth or alternatively wander the streets and visit the many interesting small shops, galleries, crafts and dolls and museums in the town, as the fancy takes you.
