Following a coffee start and briefing we depart Cruising Classic Headquarters in a leisurely cruise to the Historic River Port town of Goolwa at the mouth of the River Murray. Travelling approx. 80km down the Fleurieu Peninsula through Meadows and Ashbourne, we make our way to the Goolwa Motor Museum. The museum, a display of 45 interesting vehicles, established by Michael Finnis only recently retired from his successful business "Collectable

Classics" in his father's footsteps, commencing his career selling R and S Series Valentins, and a period spanning greater than 20 years dealing in classic cars he has tucked a few aside along the way. Together with rallying and racing with business partner, Clem Smith, an amazing range of make and models have passed through his hands. Lunch is available at either of the 3 bakeries or two hotels all within the town's main street.

Before departing the town, a must is a visit to the waterfront area, where it is recommended to utilise a 2 for 1 offer entry to the Signal Point River Murray Interpretive centre.

Return to Adelaide at your own leisure retracing the route down or the main road, through Victor Harbor and Mt. Compass or through Strathalbyn and Mt. Barker down the South Eastern Freeway.
